Measuring the effectiveness of new decals on waste sorting accuracy at Yaletown-Roundhouse Community Centre

ECONOMIC

By diverting waste, city-owned buildings can save money on landfill waste collection.

HOW?

Naturalistic Observations

ENVIRONMENTAL

Landfills account for 25% of Canada's methane gas emissions (Landfills, 2012).

WHY?

SOCIAL Encourages communities to create a culture of waste awareness and reduction.

FINDINGS

Top 5 Items Sorted Incorrectly



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Paper Towel & Napkins 5 Drink

Cans Candy Wrappers Sorting Accuracy Before, During, & After Decal Implementation*



*Findings were not significant

IMPLICATIONS

Will help the City of Vancouver decide if the decals should be implemented in all cityowned buildings

Provides the city with valuable information about which waste items are being sorted correctly and incorrectly

Raises awareness about waste stations at Roundhouse Community Centre
