 Vancouver taxpayers can save money by reducing paper cup usage<sup>2</sup> \$2.5 million per year<sup>2</sup>


Our Approach


- We created a video regarding paper coffee cup reduction

Motivations for reducing the usage of paper cups






## **Our survey results**


1) 90% of respondents are willing to use less paper cups
