
# Richmond Food Asset Map



#### Purpose

Vancouver Coastal Health (VCH) is interested in making a food asset map - a simple to use information hub comprised of community partners sharing community kitchen and food programs available to the local population.

## Demographics of Richmond



38.5% of population earning household income of less than \$40 000 (VCH, 2017)



25% of children living in poverty (VCH, 2017)

### Project Goal

To identify food assets and collect feedback on map from partners

#### Process

Collect data on food assets via internet and email

Add components to Richmond Food Asset Map (RFAM)

Organise data into excel spreadsheet

Obtain feedback on RFAM from interviewing 2 community partners

#### Results

-17 kitchen and food programs located in Richmond -2 interviews conducted with VCH staff for feedback on map



Map was straightforwar

straightforward and easy to navigate



Useful for dietitians to refer food assets to clients

#### Future development



Promote map on social media



Include transit information



Update map at least once a year

#### Take home message

Community members believe the food asset map is a very useful tool but agree that more promotion is needed.
