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BACKGROUND



Food security is compromised for people who experience poverty and low income. [1]



25% of Richmond households are affected by low income and poverty.

FOOD ASSET MAP

Vancouver Coastal Health is putting together the Richmond Food Asset Map (RFAM).

A tool that locates places one can buy, grow, and engage with food production (food assets)[2]

The aim is to increase access and awareness of local food assets to help address food insecurity.[2]

- To identify and add urban farms in Richmond onto the existing food asset map
- To test and assess the food asset map
