It means that all community residents have safe, nutritious and sustainable food.


# **Richmond Facts**



## What have we done?


- Identified and organized data of 16 Low Cost Meals food assets



- Hard Copy for noncomputer users


#### **Content and Designs:**


- Update information regularly
